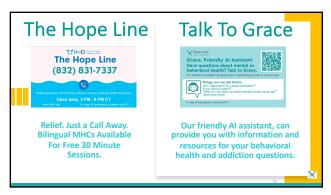












Houston MHC Join Us for Breakfast
